Be More Than an Admirer, Be a Disciple

Prior to Jesus returning to heaven, Matthew tells us that Jesus informed His apostles that He had been given all power (Matt. 28:18). He had come into the world to remove darkness and to be the light of the world (Jo. 8:12). He charged His apostles to go "make disciples" (Matt. 28:19). One of the great needs in the church and the world today is a willingness for more people to become disciples of Jesus. Are you an admirer or a disciple? There's a difference between an admirer and a disciple. An admirer is a person who is pulled toward someone because of what he or she can receive from the person. In John 6, Jesus rebuked some of the multitude who were following Him not because they believed in Him, but because some were following just for the meal – they were simply admirers (Jo. 6:26). What is your motive? Why are you following Jesus? Are you an admirer or a disciple?

An admirer may have read or heard about Jesus' goodness and sacrifices and has developed an appreciation for what He has done. One of the problems with an admirer is the person has not committed or surrendered his or her life to Christ. On Sundays and Wednesdays, the person can behave and look like a disciple of Christ. The person feels and thinks that he or she is a disciple of Christ.

The admirer, in ways, resembles the Rich Young Ruler of Matthew 19:16-30. The young man was a student of the law; he understood the law and practiced most of the law. He looked like a disciple; then came the defining point or difference between an admirer and a disciple. A disciple is willing to pay the price to be a disciple of Christ. The person is willing to surrender his heart and life to the person he is following (cf. Matt. 16:24). There is a noticeable change in the person's life that is seen by all around him or her (cf. Gal. 2:20).

A disciple understands there's a cost and he or she is willing to pay the price. The Rich Young Ruler when given an opportunity to become a disciple, Matthew says he "went away sorrowful for he had great possessions" (Matt. 19:22). The young man admired what he heard and saw in Jesus. When it came time to be transformed from an admirer to the status of a disciple, he was unwilling to pay the price. To be a disciple means a willingness to surrender your life to Christ. Are you an admirer or a disciple?






