AN ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT THE **ANNOUNCEMENTS**



As noted by the elders, we are making adjustments in the expedient parts of our worship service. Our goal is to be as timely as possible so that we have ample time for our Sunday School classes. The worship service is certainly a vital part of our time together with God and with one another. Additionally, the Bible classes are an enriching time together as we focus on further learning of the principles of Christ for our daily living. We have seen that when announcements and other expedient areas of the worship service continue for an extended time, it reduces our ability to spend the needed time in our Bible classes and causes the teachers to have to hurry through the lesson.

Therefore, the following will apply:

- A. The "call to order" at the beginning of the service will be shortened. Please see the journal for the names of those leading in the worship service.
- B. The announcements will be shortened, in that:
- 1. Except on rare occasions, the announcements that are in the journal will not be verbally repeated. See the journal for announcements and upcoming activities.
- 2. Thank you cards from members will be acknowledged, but the content will not be read by the announcer. The cards will be posted on the bulletin board for all to see. [Note: do not place the card on the bulletin board your self. Please mail the card or turn it in to the church office. Nothing is to be placed on the bulletin board without coming through the church office first.]
- C. We want to cut down on "last minute" announcements as much as possible.
 - 1. Announcements should be mailed in, faxed or called in to the church office by noon each Thursday. [If the announcement could have been submitted, but is brought in on Sunday, it may not be announced. Note: this does not apply to news about sickness, death notices, etc. We recognize that these events can occur at any time.]
- D. Each Sunday, a reminder will be shown on the screens to encourage us to read the Journal and note upcoming events and to turn off our cell phones.

God wants us to *grow in grace and in the knowledge of our* Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, 2 Peter 3:18. Therefore, we want to be sure to focus adequately on worshipping God in spirit and in truth; and in feeding on the word of God in Bible Classes. AN EFFECTIVE MINISTRY (If We Use It Effectively)

There can be no doubt that the Lord wants us to be engaged in these two works: evangelizing the lost (Mark 16:15-16) and shining our light by what we do among those who are the lost (Matthew 5:16). Philippians 2:14-16 tells us that we shine as lights in the world. 1 Peter 2:9 says that we are God's chosen, special people who proclaim (with our lips, our lives and our

living) the praises of God who has called us into His marvelous light.

There are various ways to accomplish those goals and various ministries that the church can engage in to fulfill these missions. One of the ways that we have chosen to do so here is by way of what we call our "card sending ministry". This ministry is designed to be an outreach tool to open the door for us to share the gospel by doing a good work in the lives of others. Therefore, we are encouraged to make full use of this ministry.

Here's how it works:

JOURNEYING.

TOGETHER

- Inside Facilities Ministry 1. You may have a neighbor, acquaintance, co-worker or family member who is not a member in Christ and who lives in the Jackson area who has experienced a special event in their lives (sickness, death, birth, etc)...
 - 2. You submit that person's name and address to Bro. Hayes or the church office and you pray daily for that person's situation and for their heart to be open to under standing God's way of truth.
 - 3. The "card sending ministry" goes to work to see to it that this person receives at least two cards of encouragement each day for two weeks.
 - 4. Subsequently, the person who receives the cards shares their appreciation for the cards with you.
 - 5. You respond by (a) inviting them to visit our services; (b) giving them some information about the congregation; (c) asking them if one of the ministers may contact them; and (d) informing one of the ministers about the contact.
 - 6. God will do His work in that person's life, along with the efforts that we put forth, to open that person's heart to hearing and obeying God's truth.

Through this ministry, we accomplish the goal of doing good in the lives of others and letting our light shine so that men will glorify God in heaven. We also may open a door for the gospel of Christ (cf. 2 Cor. 2:12; Col. 4:3). Let us use this ministry effectively by our personal participation in submitting names of those whom you know who are in need of encouragement.


